Scholarship award: \$15,000

Two weeks of orientation in Canin Associates' Orlando office to become familiar with company and identify research project - lodging provided

Two weeks in Canin Associates' Orlando office to present findings and complete documentation in report format

Recent degree in landscape architecture, urban design, city planning, or architecture from the University of Miami (master's degree preferred)

Expressed interest in research to advance the design profession in the area of community design and placemaking

Current resume accompanied by work samples, sketches, written product, and other materials demonstrating research skills, graphic abilities, and design talent

30-day selection process - Brian and Myrna Canin, along with a small committee, may meet with each candidate and/or review portfolio of individual work completed

Nominees will be interviewed on why they should be chosen, followed by a question and answer period
